


- Miss Debbie will act as narrator and director of this 7-Act Play called “No Bullies in the Kingdom.” The play lasts 50 minutes.
- The teachers should select the students who will play the parts of the 59 characters in the play. Please pre-assign these parts prior to the day of the “Be Bully Free” program.
- The students do NOT have to memorize their lines. During the play rehearsal in the gym, Miss Debbie will tell them their lines. During the actual play, Miss Debbie will whisper to them what they should say before putting the microphone in front of their mouths. It is a system that works very well. It is the students’ jobs to say these lines with as much as enthusiasm and personality as possible.

- We will practice this play one time only prior to lunch. After lunch, we will perform this play for the entire student body plus any parents you wish to invite and any members of the press.
- Miss Debbie provides her sound system plus all 59 one-size-fits-all costumes.
- Here are audition lines you can use. Pick eager volunteers to play each role.
- Eleven (11) of the characters must be played by boys. Thirteen (13) of the characters must be played by girls. Thirty-five (35) of the characters can either be played by boys or girls.
